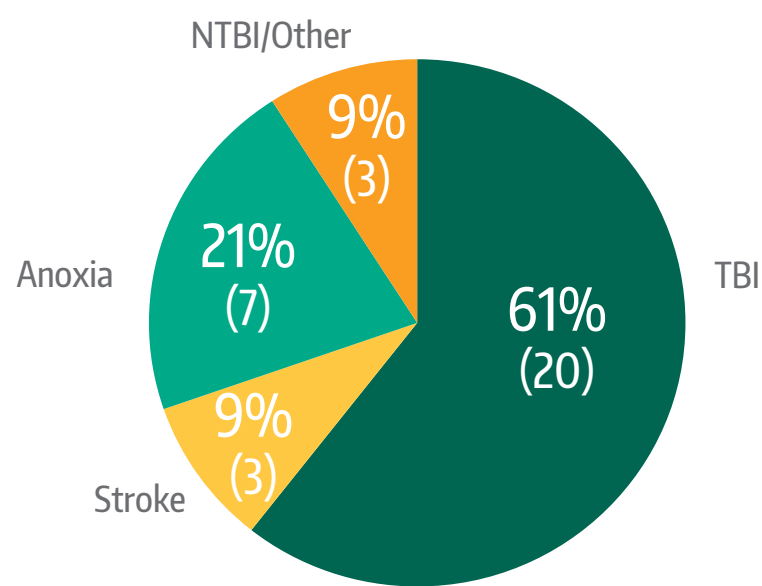
In Fiscal Year 2022, On With Life's Long-Term Skilled Care program served 33 individuals (7 females and 26 males).

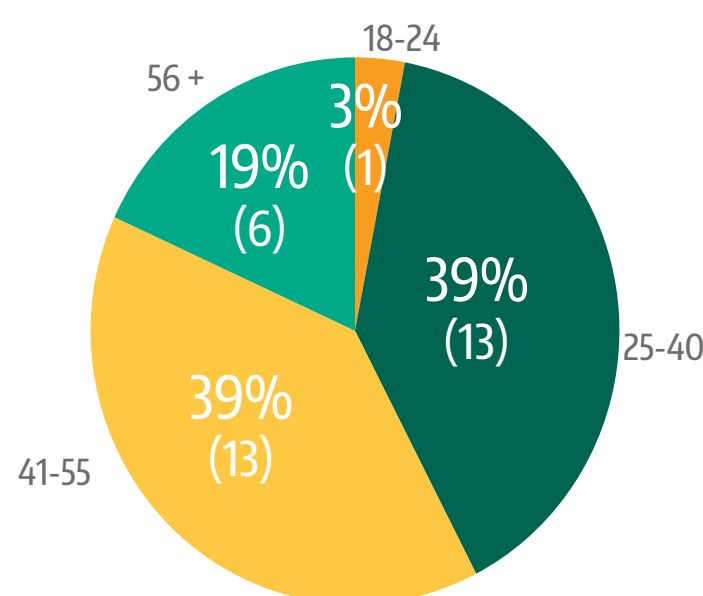
QUALITY OF LIFE for our persons served was measured across a wide variety of categories.



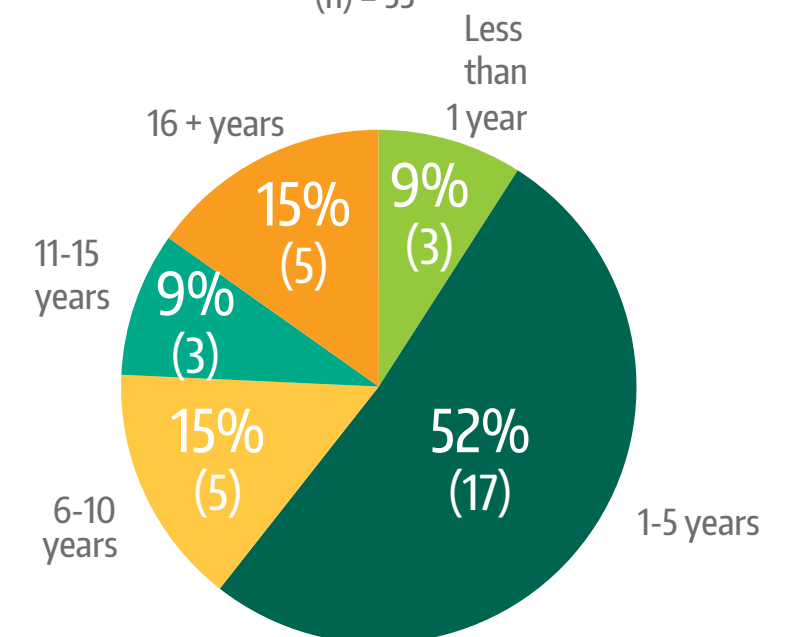
TYPE OF INJURY
(n) = 33



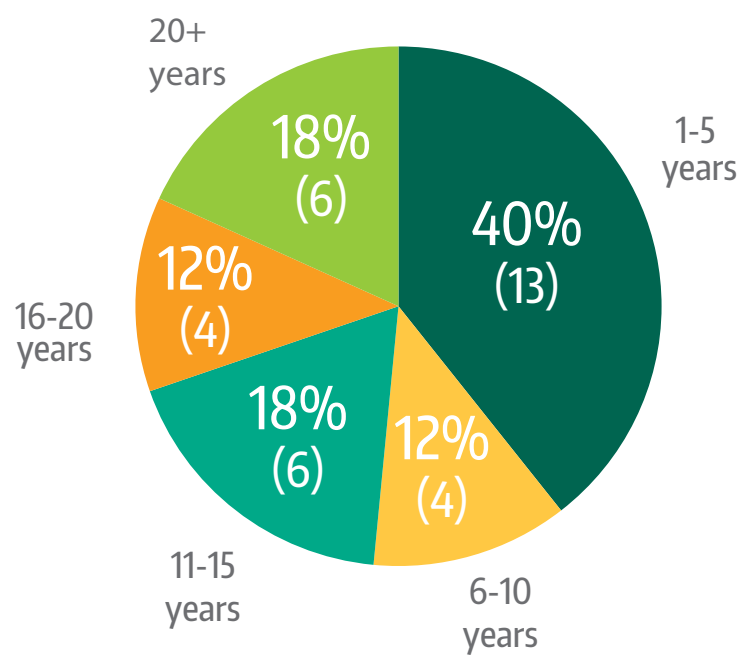
AGES SERVED
(n) = 33



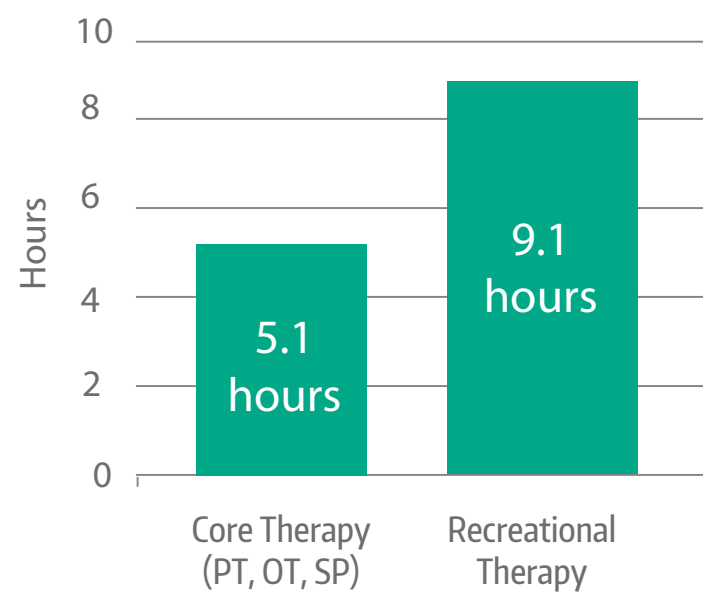
LENGTH OF STAY
(n) = 33



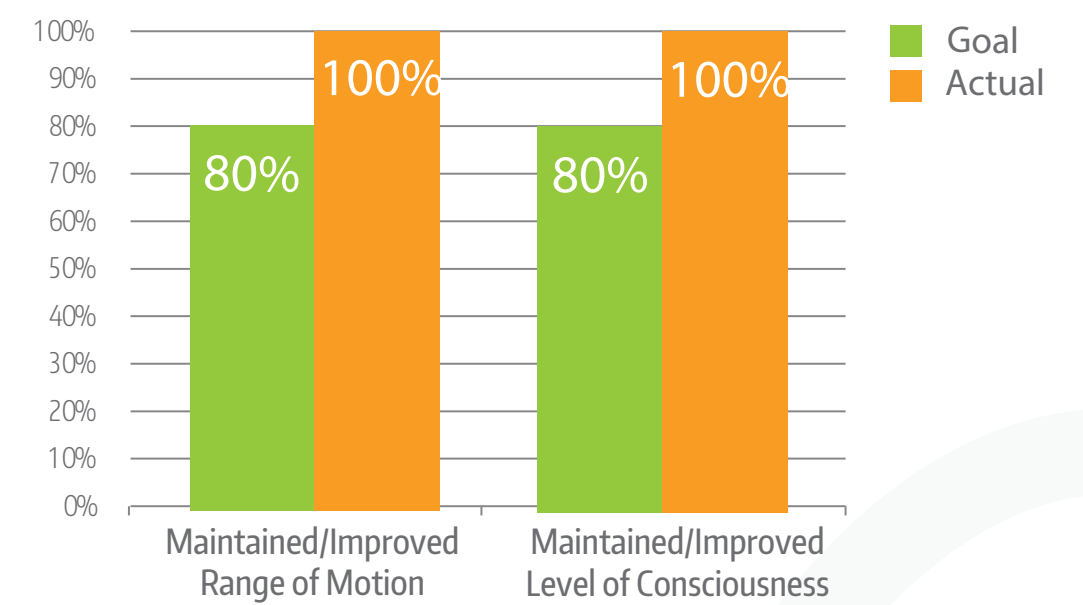
NUMBER OF YEARS POST-INJURY
(n) = 33



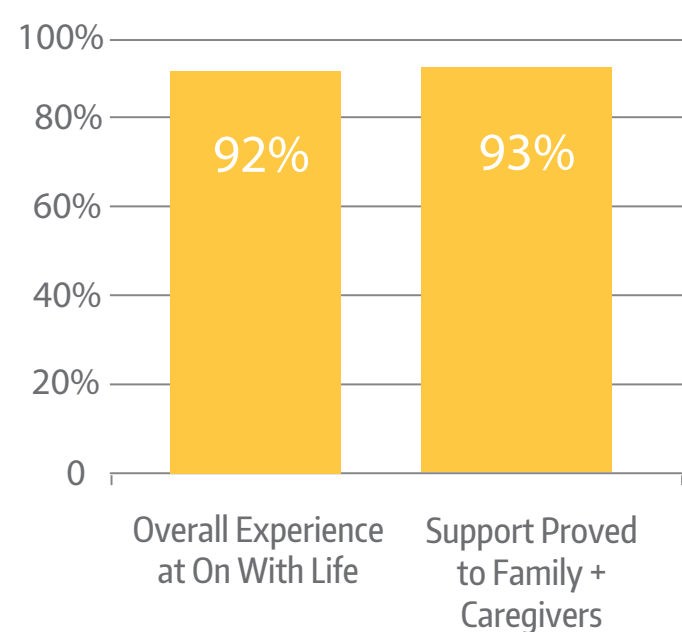
THERAPY DELIVERED

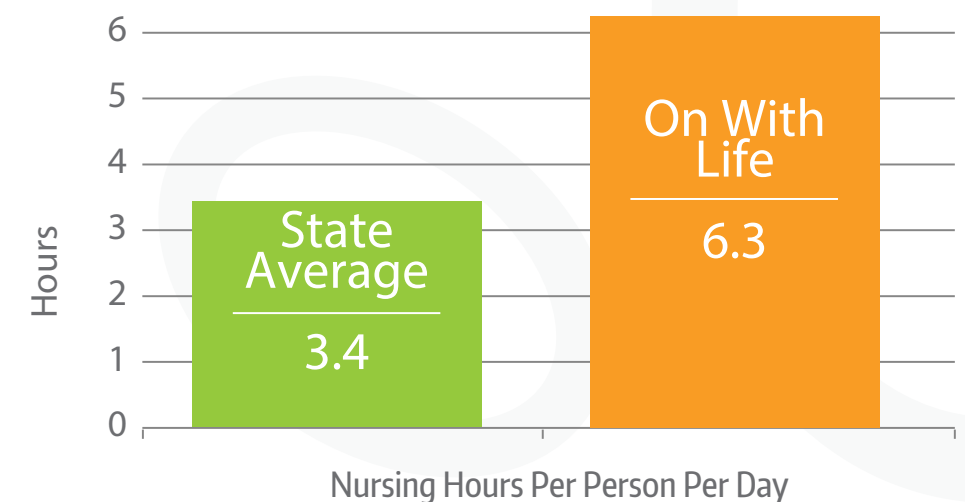
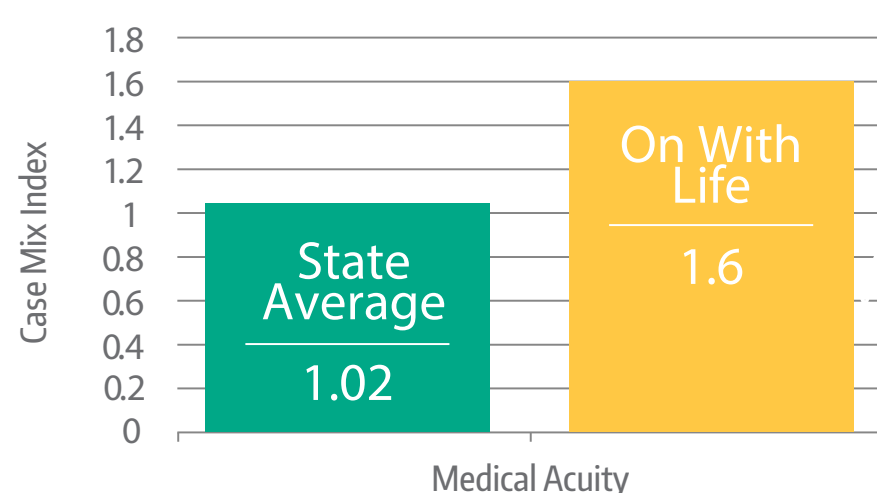

MEDICAL ACUITY & NURSING HOURS

The medical acuity (the severity of an illness/injury) of the individuals we serve at On With Life is higher than most other non-hospital facilities in the state of Iowa (data collected from the Iowa Department of Human Services Nursing Facility Rates - State Fiscal Year 2022). The On With Life nursing ratio per person per day far exceeds the state and national averages (date collected from cms.gov - Nursing Homes including rehabilitation services - October 2022 datasets).
